Fiscal Impact Statement Criteria

Before the Office of Financial Management (OFM) State Human Resources Division can approve certain changes to the <u>state's job classification and compensation structures</u>, the OFM Budget Division must review and approve the fiscal impact of those changes. To do this, agencies/institutions need to complete a Personnel Fiscal Impact Statement (FIS) form for certain proposed actions.
